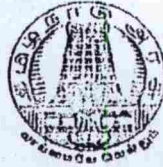



- c) *to encourage the students to coin new "Slogans" about the needs of elections and participation of the public in it.*
- d) *the above activities are carried out well before the commencement of the annual examinations. i.e. before March 2011.*
- e) *Conducting street plays and other modes to create awareness on election & participation can also be included*

3. The action taken report in this regard may be informed to the Government in Public (Election) Department as well as in Higher Education Department immediately.
