website of the College - Instructions Issued - Reg.

I am, by direction to state that as per the provisions in Clause 10(3) of the NCTE's Regulations issued in 2009 and as well as in 2014, the Colleges of Education have to display certain specific details of them in their official website periodically. Further, in the Recognition orders issued by the NCTE, it has been clearly stated that each and every College of Education has to maintain the college website in order to display certain mandatory information of their Colleges of Education.

But, in reality, many of the Colleges of Education have neither created nor maintained a Website for their Colleges and even the Websites already created by certain colleges are found inactive. This is a clear violation of Regulations by most of the Colleges of Education, in respect of maintaining the websites.

Under the above circumstances, the following instructions are issued for strict implementations from the beginning of the academic year 2018-2019.

1. The college shall create an official college website in the name of the College immediately, if already not done.
2. College having inactive website shall take immediate step to activate and update the details.
3. Shall incorporate the name of the College website in the letter head of the College and correspondent with the University in future.
4. Shall maintain and update its website as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display the following as mandatory disclosure.
 - a. Balance sheet as on the last date of the financial year;
 - b. Income and expenditure account for the financial year;
 - c. Receipt and payment account for the financial year;
 - d. Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
 - e. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph;
 - f. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last, quarter;

- g. Names of students admitted during the current session along with qualification, percentage of marks in the qualifying examination, date of admission, etc.
- h. Fee charged from students;
- i. Available infrastructure facilities;
- j. Facilities added during the last quarter;
- k. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter.
- l. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application;
- m. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information. If it so desires.
- n. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition and provisional affiliation.

Further, as already directed in the reference cited all the Colleges of Education shall appoint a full time, regular and qualified Principal immediately in the place of Principal in charge, if already not done so.

A full time, regular and qualified Principal alone is capable of administering Teacher Education Institution as stipulated in the Regulations in order to enhance the standard of Teacher Education. Also, maintain and update the College website with all information to provide to the Public. Hence, the Principals/Managements of all the Colleges of Education affiliated to the University are strictly instructed to appoint a qualified Principal and post all the mandatory details on the college website, before starting admissions of B.Ed/M.Ed/B.Sc.B.Ed students for the academic year 2018-2019.

In the event of non-compliance of the above instructions (i.e.) appointment of full time Principal & creation of official college website, the admission if any made to the above programmes will not be accepted for approval of admission in the academic year 2018-2019.
