I am to inform you that the Additional Secretary to Government, Public (Law & Order.B) Department, Secretariat in his letter dated 27.01.2012 addressed to the Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Higher Education Department and the Principal Secretary to Government, Labour and Employment Department informed as follows:

“The bank robbery in the Bank of Baroda branch at Peungudi, Chennai was discussed in the Law & Order Meeting chaired by the Chief Secretary on 24.01.2012. It was informed that the perpetrators of this robbery were conversing in Hindi and that they could be migrant labourers or students from other States and the investigation is in progress based on some vital clues. The Chief Secretary informed that the Labour and Employment Department has a registered database on migrant labourers and this could be shared with the Police Department. With regard to students from other States, it was suggested that the college authorities could be requested to furnish at least the information regarding students who are residing outside the hostels as this could be of help to the Police.”

I request that all the principals of affiliated colleges to bestow top priority to furnish at least the information regarding students who are residing outside the hostels on or before 05.03.2012.
