In the letter cited, the Government of Tamil Nadu has informed as follows:

“The Central Vigilance Commission has decided to observe the Vigilance Awareness Week from 29<sup>th</sup> October (Monday) to 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2012 (Saturday) and the theme of observing Vigilance Awareness Week this year is “Transparency in Public Procurement”. It expects public organizations to introduce e-procurement, e-payment, etc., by leveraging technology and make measurable progress in the days ahead in this regard. It emphasizes the public officials to act with integrity, without any fear of favour. Wherever there is a knowledge gap with regard to public procurement, measures for proper capacity building should be undertaken.

In order to observe the Vigilance Awareness Week, the following activities during this period may be advised to be observed along with taking a oath as enclosed herewith.

- To display banners, posters, etc., at prime locations in their offices
- To organize seminars/workshops inviting prominent faculty
- To organize competitive debates/lectures on anti-corruption topics amongst the employees and the students in the Colleges/Schools and to distribute prizes.
- To bring out special issue of journals during the period; and
- To request the non-governmental organizations, institutions and service associations in the local area to participate in the vigilance awareness campaign.

In the letter cited at reference 2, the Secretary to Governor, Raj Bhavan has also requested for necessary action and report on the above subject.

The Managements of the Colleges of the Education shall observe vigilance observation week and forward a consolidated report to the Central Vigilance Commission.
