Sub: Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare – Prevention of atrocities – Schedules Castes and Scheduled Tribes (PoA) (Amendment) -Rules 1995 notified in the Gazette of India – Reg.

2. Letter No.16970/A2/2014-1, dated 23.09.2014 from the Deputy Secretary to Government, Higher Education (A2) Department.

In the letter cited, the Deputy Secretary to Government along with the letter cited at ref. has enclosed a copy of the G.O. (D) No.192, dated 09.09.2014, which reads as follows.

“The Government of India have requested the State Government to consider the views on the increase in relief amount to atrocity victims which works to around 1.5 times (between Rs.75,000/- to Rs.7,50,000/- of the existing rates (between Rs.50,000/- to Rs.5,00,000/-).

Further, in the letter it is also stated that the Director (SCD), Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, based on the suggestions obtained from all the State Government / Union Territories, concerned Central Ministries, National Commission for Scheduled Castes, the Government of India has further amended the Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes (PoA) Rules 1995, which was earlier amended during the year 2011.


As per the amendment, the relief amount to atrocity victims has been further increased by 50% (i.e) between Rs.75,000/- to Rs.7,50,000/- depending upon the nature of offences. He has also stated that the Government of India, has also notified the above said amendment in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part-II, Section 3, Sub-section 3, Sub-section (i) on 23.06.2014 and requested that adequate publicity of the amendment Rules may be made in print and electronic media for the benefit of target groups and also for the general public.

The Government after considering the suggestions of the Government of India have decided to ensure adequate publicity for the implementation of the amended Rules in the State. Accordingly, all the Officers mentioned in the address entry are requested to give wide publicity to intimate about the Amendment made to the Rules and the increased relief amount which were published in Gazette notification to all the officials concerned under their control for the benefit of the target groups and also for the general

public and also requested the Officials to send a compliance report to the Government early for sending the confirmation report to the Government.

Hence, all the Chairpersons / Correspondents / Principals of the Affiliated Colleges of this University are requested to ensure adequate publicity of the above amendments and implement the amended rules in the State.

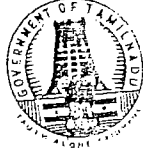

In the letter first read above, the Government of India have requested this Government to furnish the considered views on the increase in relief amount to atrocity victims which works out to around 1.5 times (between Rs. 75,000/- to Rs. 7,50,000/-) of the existing rates (between Rs. 50,000/- to Rs. 5,00,000/-).

In the Government D.O. letter fourth cited, based on the details furnished by the Director of Adi Dravidar Welfare and Additional Director General of Police, the considered views of this Government on the proposed enhancement of relief amount to atrocity victims have been forwarded to Government of India.

In the Government of India letter fifth read above, the Director (SCD), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India has stated that based on the suggestions obtained from all the State Governments/Union Territories, concerned Central Ministries, National Commission for Scheduled Castes, the Government of India has further amended the Scheduled Castes/Scheduled Tribes

(PoA) Rules 1995, which has been earlier amended during the year 2011. As per the above amendment, the relief amount to atrocity victims has been further increased by 50% (i.e) between Rs. 75,000/- to Rs. 7,50,000/- depending upon the nature of offences. He has also stated therein that the Government of India has also notified the above said amendment in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part - II, Section 3 Sub-section (i) on 23.6.2014 and requested that adequate publicity of the amendment Rules may be made in print and electronic media for the benefit of target groups and also for the general public.

4. The Government after considering the suggestions of the Government of India have decided to ensure adequate publicity for the implementation of the amended Rules in this State. Accordingly, all the Officers mentioned in the address entry are requested to give wide publicity to intimate about the Amendment made to the Rules and the increased relief amount which were published in Gazette notification to all the officials concerned under their control for the benefit of the target groups and also for the general public.
