Sub: Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University – Grant of permission for admission of students to M.Phil Degree Course for the Academic Year 2010-2011 - Reg.

The permission is hereby granted for admission of students to M.Phil Degree Programme for the academic year 2010-2011 to the autonomous and non-autonomous colleges of education offering M.Phil Degree Programme. The colleges shall proceed to admit the students as per the sanctioned strength approved to the individual college not exceeding 12 students.

Non-Autonomous Colleges of Education

1. Required notification shall be issued and the students for M.Phil Degree Course shall be admitted as per the guidelines provided in the Syllabus. The Regulations and Syllabus for the M.Phil Degree Programme for non-autonomous colleges shall be as prescribed for the year 2009-2010.
2. The examinations for the Papers I and II for the candidates who have been admitted during the year 2010-2011 shall be held during August 2011.
3. The examination time table for the year 2010-2011 will be sent to the colleges as soon as it is finalized.
4. The last date for submission of dissertations shall be 31.10.2011.

Autonomous Colleges of Education

1. In respect of autonomous colleges of education the approval of UGC granting autonomous status shall be submitted to the University.
2. Such colleges shall design suitable application forms for admission of candidates and proceed with the admission as per the minimum eligibility condition prescribed by the University, as prescribed for the year 2009-2010.
3. The Syllabus and Regulations approved by the Board of Studies/Academic Council of the respective autonomous colleges shall be followed strictly.
4. After completion of the admission the names of the candidates admitted for full time and part time M.Phil Degree Programme for the academic year 2010-2011 shall be sent to the University for approval.

The last date for admission of the students to M.Phil Degree Course for the year 2010-2011 shall be 30.09.2010 for both autonomous and non-autonomous colleges of education.
